Together we can give all children:



JUST ASK ANJALI

In the remote district of Udayapur a small, poor and secluded community, we met Anjali. At four years old she lost her father, her mother was left to care and provide for 5 children. With little to no food for the family, Anjali and some of her siblings had to work to support their mother, meaning no time for school only work.

With the small piece of land her mother Binda now owns, they have built a home. Binda was aslo able to access one of our farmer's grants and runs a small business, to support her income she sells mushrooms! Because of this, Anjali can now to go to school every day where she enjoys reading, writing and catching up with her friends.

Anjali is now 11. Since Save the Children's livelihood project hit the ground in 2014 her family is striving and she is no longer one in the 40% of children in Udayapur who are malnourished, uneducated and in danger of exploitation.

With vital funds from our supporters we have trained and impacted over 400 farmers in Udayapur district, with over 64% significantly increasing their income. This has meant that they can provide food for their families and their children with an ongoing education.

FUNDRAISING TIPS AND TRICKS

Most people who donate to your fundraising efforts do so for one reason – because YOU asked! It may sound simple, but it's true. Your friends and family are donating to support you and your cause. So the more people you ask to support you, the more money you will raise.

ASKING FOR A DONATION IN 5 EASY STEPS

- 1. Identify what you're fundraising for
- 2. Explain why it is important to you
- 3. Share what you're doing about it
- 4. Ask people to take a specific action
- 5. ...and make sure to say thank you!

Sample Ask

Too many children in our world don't have the chance to go to school. They get left behind because of who they are or where they're from. As someone who has grown up with so many opportunities, I find this unacceptable and I want to do something about it. Will you help me?
