Amplifying the voices of tamariki and rangatahi in New Zealand on climate action.



Tēnā Koe,

As climate change continues to escalate, our young people are leading at the forefront of navigating this change and fighting for a better future for generations to come. We saw 170,000 young people march for climate change here in Aotearoa in 2019, but the weight of the climate crisis and responsibility of this is not on our young people to bear. It is on you, as our leaders to lead us through one of the biggest challenges this generation faces, climate change.

We have gathered messages from children and youth across New Zealand with their messages to you, our decision makers about the climate crisis. These pages are filled with over 150 messages from tamariki and rangatahi as young as 6 through to 22. These messages will also be presented to world leaders at the UN SDG Summit in New York this year alongside children's messages from across the globe.

These messages are filled with both hope and devastation, as we face one of the biggest crises in human history. We ask that you read these messages and make decisions with the tamariki and rangatahi of Aotearoa in mind, they are watching you. In the words of 8-year-old Ted, "Be brave and make strong, wise decisions."

Ngā mihi nui for the work you do every day to make New Zealand a greater place to live in. You will see throughout these messages that your hard work does not go unseen, but also know that our children are counting on you to give them the future they deserve. Together, we can create change.

- "Be proactive and put in policies that will reduce carbon emissions."





"Remove the social stigma around climate change and normalise the issue being a general conversation, rather than a political one."


