
HOME LEARNING TILES

Read to someone special! Choose a favourite story to read to an adult, family pet or stuffed animal. Try reading your story over the phone (or Zoom!) to other family members or friends.






CHILD-FRIENDLY RESTAURANT

After the sun sets, go outside with a trusted adult and look up at the night sky. Draw what you see on a piece of paper.





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




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FLASHLIGHT STORIES







BRING A BOOK TO LIFE


Have your child draw the characters from their favorite book, then cut out the figures to make puppets. See what happens when your children have control of the characters!

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









DREAMLAND

Look online for a girl who raises her voice to demand change, learn all about her.






LEADER FOR A DAY
